

Stand Sunday Ideas for Your Church

- Include our church bulletin insert in program.
- Put up flyers in the foyer or fellowship hall of church.
- Allow The CALL representative to set up an info table before the service.
- Collection Drive for items needed for children in foster care serviced by The CALL malls.
- Create and/or distribute prayer cards for children awaiting adoptive families.
- Set aside time of intercessory [prayer](#) for foster children.
- Write letters or cards of encouragement to foster children.
- Plan a foster care related [sermon](#) on Stand Sunday.
- Plan a set of worship songs that reflect God's heart for the foster children, include the church youth or children's choir.
- Because we believe that local foster families are missionaries, commission the families in your church who are open homes or have decided to step into foster care in the next year.
- Stage a visual representation of the foster children in your community, such as a pair of shoes on the church stage.
- Invite a former foster youth to speak to congregation.
- Invite an adoptive, foster, or respite family to speak to church.
- Invite someone from The CALL to speak during the service.
- Plan a fundraiser to benefit foster families supported by The CALL.
- Take a love offering to benefit The CALL and their work with foster families.
- Gather together a small group and watch a foster care related movie together and discuss.
- Plan a service project to benefit an adoptive or foster family through the family support services offered through The CALL
- Host a breakfast or lunch for local DFCS workers.
- Host a 'date night' for local adoptive, foster and host families.
- Bake/Take a meal to a local adoptive or foster family or supply The CALL with freezer meals to be used with foster and adoptive families having a crisis day.
- Host a live webinar on social media to educate others on the foster children care issues that burden your heart.
